

Vaccination in the Kosovo system




COVID-19 VACCINATION



After the arrival of the first doses of the AstraZeneca vaccine in late March, vaccinations began in Kosovo at the beginning of April 2021

The first contingents of the vaccine were distributed among all municipalities in Kosovo, except those with a Serb majority

The quality of the Serbian language translations on the internet portal for registering for the vaccine is very poor

-  A larger quantity of vaccines arrived in Kosovo during the month of May
-  With the exception of Novo Brdo, no vaccination centers have been opened in Serb-majority municipalities
-  The Kosovo Ministry of Health claimed that there are no vaccines in Serb communities due to the small number of requests for vaccination received from Serb-majority municipalities
